

OVERVIEW OF CDBG PROGRAM

- Grants to help "develop" the community
- Entitlement communities receive annual award on a formula basis
- categories:
 - Admin (20% cap)
 - Public Services (15% cap)
 - Permanent Housing
 - Public Facilities and Infrastructure
 - Improvements
- City typically funds 4-7 projects per year
- Specifically for Meridian residents

• Meridian divides funding into four (4)

These are the main components of the CDBG Program that the City of Meridian is responsible for.

CONSOLIDATED P **PLANNING & ANALYZIN**

Five-year plan that ide housing and commun development needs. strategies to meet go.

3 PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION ACTIVITY

Service/activity provided to community. Staff involved in reimbursements, progress reports, monitoring, etc.

2 ACTION PLAN **ANNUAL GOALS**

Identifies specific projects and actions to meet goals of Con Plan. Acts as application for funding.

4 CAPER REPORTING

End of year report of accomplishments and progress toward goals identified in Con Plan.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Federal regulations only allow certain entities to apply for funds.

Income Eligibility


Participants must be at or below 80% AMI.


ANTICIPATED FUNDING



APPLICATION COMPONENTS

- **NEW** <u>Prequalification</u>: Establishes Eligibility
- <u>Narrative</u>: Information about the Organization and Project
- Financial: Comparison of Total Funding and Meridian CDBG Funding for this Project
- <u>Outcomes:</u>Objectives for the Program • **Tip:** Collaborate with the team responsible for reporting on the goals to ensure they are both reportable and accurate.
- Documentation
 - Tip: Client Approval/National Objective documentation usually serves as an application to assess eligibility for the program.

• <u>Required Documents:</u> Necessary Supporting

- Submit: Certifications and Signature
 - **Tip:** This should be completed by an authorized
 - individual, using their own login credentials.
